

HOME-BASED CARE COURSE LEVELS 1, 2, & 3

PRESENTERS

- 1. A Registered Professional Nurse with certificates and up-to-date SANC registration.
- 2. A Qualified Lecturer in Communication.
- 3. An assessor to assist with interviews, assessments, and final oral and written exams.

ASSESSMENT / INTERVIEW OF STUDENTS

Interviews will be conducted to discuss course content and conditions (i.e., time, attendance, and full payment before course commencement).

ENROLMENT

ONLY PERSONS WITH SOUTH AFRICAN ID OR PERSONS WITH A VALID PASSPORT FROM OTHER COUNTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED

Enrolment for Level 2 is only permitted after Level 1 has been completed. Enrolment for Level 3 is only allowed if Level 2 has been completed.

ASSESSMENT TOOL

The aim is to measure oral, written, and comprehension abilities, with daily assessments of completed work.

COST

Level 1

R2,000.00 per student (includes course book, examination, and certificate). A deposit of R1,000.00 is required, with the balance of R1,000.00 due before exams. Certificate valid for 3 years.

Levels 2 & 3 (presented as one course)

R3,000.00 per student (includes course book, examinations, and certificates). A deposit of R1,500.00 is needed, with the balance of R1,500.00 due before the first exam.

DURATION

Level 1

7 days, 32 hours total, including three hours of studying (covering both theory and practical work).

Levels 2 & 3

16 days from 09:00 to 15:00 each day (covering both theory and practical work).

MODULES

Levels 2 & 3

Courses consist of 15 modules, with 2-3 modules covered per day.

A 50% pass rate is required in both theory and practical assessments.

Practical assessment will take place during class.

EXAMINATIONS

Level 1

Theory: 2 hours, 50% pass required. Practical: 30 minutes, 50% pass required.

Level 2

Theory: Multiple choice, sentences, and paragraphs. 45 minutes, 50% pass required. Practical hours: 360 hours post-training. If the 360 hours were completed after Level 1, the student does not need to complete them again.

Level 3

Time allocation: 3 hours, 50% pass required.
